“Growing up, I had always wanted to have superpowers,” shares Dr. Tracy Chandler, radiologist at Richmond Hospital. “And no matter how much I wished I could fly or become invisible, it just never happened. I could not lift off and I was always in plain sight. But years later, one superpower did eventually come true, and that was x-ray vision.”

“As a child, having x-ray vision meant you could see through walls and discover hidden treasures. You could see what was happening even in enclosed spaces, and you could take action to help people before anyone else could see there was a problem. Now, as a radiologist at Richmond Hospital, I am able to use medical imaging equipment to see into our patients, then help diagnose and treat them.”

Arrival of the New MRI Machine



2023 Milestones Accomplished

- Early Childhood Mental Health, Noakes and Outpatient Pediatrics moved across the street to facilitate construction of the new tower
- Programs and services previously located in the Rotunda moved to the renovated fifth floor of the original hospital North Tower
- The Diabetes Education Centre moved to the Community Health Access Centre on Alderbridge Way
- Construction started on the interim Psychiatric Assessment Unit next to the Emergency Department

- Demolition


